

## AMENDMENT TO EXISITING TRASH PICK-UP POLICY

To: Residents of the City of Loganville

- 1). All household garbage will be picked up once per week depending on your address on either Tuesday, Thursday or Friday by the contracted company that the City of Loganville contracts with. (NOTE: No paint cans that contain paint will be picked up)
- 2). Leaves, limbs and debris must be separated from trash items before it will be picked up.
- 3). All leaves, grass and small bush clippings (must be placed in brown bags), limbs and other debris must be placed at the curb, near the street, on the shoulder between the ditch and the street to the backside of the ditch by 7:00 am on your scheduled pick up day. NONE of these Items shall be placed on the street or in a drainage ditch. Any leaves or other yard debris placed in plastic bags will NOT be picked up.
- 4). All metal products, i.e., Refrigerators, Freezers, etc. must have the FREON removed by a certified appliance company and red tagged by the company before the City of Loganville Public Works Department can pick it up. Once this has been done you may contact us at (770)466-0902 and we will pick up the item within 72 hour business hours (depending on work load/weather).
- 5). All other bulk trash must be placed at the curb for pick up by 7:00 am. Once placed at the curb, please contact the City of Loganville Public Works Department to arrange a pick-up. The City does not run a daily route for these items. All items will be picked up within 72 business hours (depending on work load/weather).
- 6). No debris, trash, refuse, rubbish, limbs or any other materials generated from outside the City will be picked up for disposal by the City or contracted removal services. Also, if at anytime a resident contracts with a private landscaper, the yard debris must be removed by the contractor.
- 7). Batteries, tires, lumber and or construction material WILL NOT BE PICKED UP. (This includes debris from remodeling, refurbishing or removal of old or existing interior or exterior structures).
- 8). All BROWN bags must be kept to a maximum of 50 lb limit or services will not be rendered until re-bagged. No more than 20 bags can be placed at a curb per pick-up or this will be considered a chargeable load. For limb piles, the size must not exceed a 6x6x4, anything over that will also be considered a chargeable load. The amount for a chargeable load is \$35.00 for each load over the limit amount. If there is a charge (at that time, nothing will be picked up) and a Charge Notice will be left on the residents' front door. It is the residents' responsibility to contact the Public Works Department @ 770-466-0902 within 72 hours. If you do not call within the 72 hours, the City of Loganville Public Works Department will pick it up and the charge will be attached to the residents water bill.
- 9). No yard debris or bulk trash items will be picked up from any businesses in the City of Loganville. It is the responsibility of the business to ensure that their property is clear of any and all items.
